

## CRUHSD PHONE POLICY

- Phones can be used in class for educational purposes. Teachers will regulate the use of cell phones in class for educational purposes. This should be noted on board and lesson plans.
- Phones must be turned off.
- Phones can be on the student, backpack or in holder.
- All electronic accessories (earbuds/headphones and so forth) will be placed in backpack or in pockets. This includes wireless earbuds. They cannot be hanging out of shirts or jackets.
- Phones can be used before school, between periods and at lunch when not in the classroom.
- No phones when using a pass out of class. They must be turned in if on the student.
- Penalties for having phone/earbuds out:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> time—phone/electronic accessories will be given to teacher and given back at end of period. Phone from now on will have to be placed in a holder in the room and not left on person or backpack.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> time—phone/electronic accessories given to teacher and teacher takes items to office to be picked up at end of day and receive a session of detention.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> time—phone/electronic accessories given to teacher and teacher takes items to office. Parents must pick up items from office and three sessions of detention.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> time or more—phone/earbuds given to teacher and teacher takes items to office. Parent must pick up items from office and student will receive 1 to 10 days OSS.
- The school is not responsible for any lost or stolen phones/electronic accessories or any other electronic device if the item is taken by a teacher for breaking the phone policy.
